Attendance


We will continue to publish the attendance data within our monthly newsletter and will continue to track attendance closely. Our school attendance target continues to be 96%.

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New this year - Reading

By now your children should have come home with a new reading diary. These are designed to be more beneficial to parents to provide advice about how to help your child read, what they need to be able to do by the end of the year and include other advice and useful tips. These are much more expensive than homework diaries so if your child loses their diary, we will be asking for a £1 contribution towards a new one. If they complete their diaries, they will be given a new one free of charge. The children should also have told you about their new reading bookmarks. These include spaces for stickers which teachers put on after a child has read to an adult and a comment has been recorded. Once the bookmark is full of stickers your child will be able to choose a free reading book to take home and keep as a reward for dedicated reading. The class 'Top Reader' will also be published in the newsletters. Mrs Clarke will be offering a 'Reading Workshop'



for all parents on Wednesday 4th October at 5pm and we look forward to seeing you all there. We will also be celebrating Roald Dahl Day and giving the children the opportunity to dress up at their favourite Roald Dahl character.
