Lots of parents were interested in the resources and guidance available on our web-site, to support your child's learning outside school. Click on the picture of the little owl on the bottom of the home page.

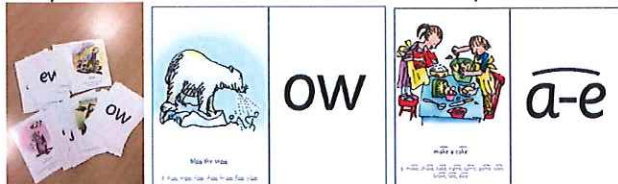


Remember that each time your child reads with an adult they will get a sticker on their bookmark. A completed bookmark will be rewarded with a free book and a named leaf on our reading tree.

In school we are currently looking at our systems for guided reading, which takes place every day. Two of these sessions include dedicated reading with an adult. There are also focus learning intentions which the teacher focuses on within that week. This information will be shared with you in your child's reading diary very soon.



At the workshop Miss Plowman demonstrated how children learn to read through phonics. She shared the speed sound cards that we use in school along with the rhymes that accompany each sound to help children to remember them. Parents expressed an interest in purchasing sets of these cards to use at home. I have placed an order for these and they will be available from the office priced at £1.50 a pack after Wednesday.
