Anti-Bullying Week

Monday 13th November - Friday 17th November 2017

There is lots happening this week to raise awareness of anti-bullying. The theme for this year is 'All different, All equal'.

Firstly all children will be discussing and agreeing the definition of 'bullying' and sharing their thoughts and views about bullying and how it makes people feel.

They will be learning about the different types of bullying (including on line bullying and harassment for KS2 children) and what that could look like.

We will be linking all of their learning to our values and what stance we take on bullying in school.

Tuesday 14th November - Wear Blue Day.

The children are invited to wear blue that day to make a stand and demonstrate that we all stand together against bullying. The children and adults will sign a whole school anti-bullying charter in their classes. Mrs Forster, our safeguarding governor will be attending the assembly to share her experiences of bullying and how this affects people's lives in her professional capacity as a Police Officer.

We will also have a visit from Billy the anti-bullying bear who will be coming to open his letterbox and take away any letters or pictures for him to respond to. The children will be reminded that they can contact him by posting something in his letter box or by sending him an e-mail. Billy's e-mail address is billy.bear@taw.org.uk
