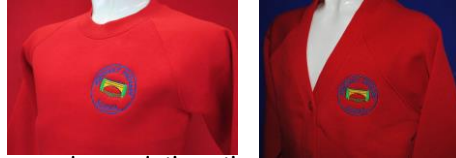


CHARTER STANDARD SCHOOLS

Thank you to those of you who have already signed and returned your Home School Agreements. Please can I remind you to send these back as soon as you can if you haven't already.

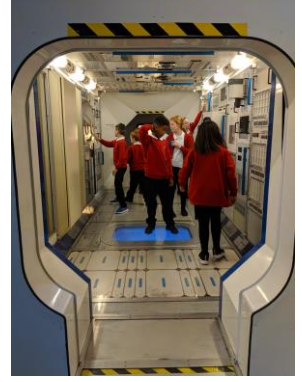
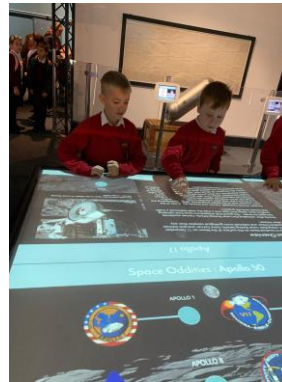
