National Lockdown

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the Prime Ministers announcement this evening, I wanted to confirm that school will now be following the government's advice and closing to most of our pupils.

Tomorrow, please only come to school if you are a key worker or if your child is classed as vulnerable. Clarification of who this may be is below.

Vulnerable: Children who have a Child in Need (CIN) plan, a Child Protection (CP) plan or are looked after children. Children who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) adopted children, those who are young carers or those who were identified as part of our vulnerable group during the last national lockdown.

Critical Workers: Any parents whose work is critical to the Covid-19 response, work in health and social care and other key sectors including the following.

- Education and Childcare
- Local and national government
- Food and distribution of other necessary goods
- Public safety and national security (e.g. police, fire and rescue, armed forces personnel)
- Utilities, communication and financial services (e.g. postal delivery, waste disposal, gas, water, electricity suppliers)

Please arrive via your normal entrance where a member of the Senior Leadership Team will be waiting to answer any questions you may have regarding your critical worker or vulnerable place in school. If you are unsure if you fit into this category, please check the government website

www.gov.uk/coronavirus or call us before coming to school tomorrow.

We ask that all parents continue to be as considerate with your requests for critical worker places as you were during the first lockdown, and carefully consider the necessity of sending your children to school as these places will be limited.
