My children enjoyed seeing and hearing their teacher. I think more lessons/things to do need to be pre-recorded so the children have some form of engagement!!

We are struggling with downloading some of the work as our device is not compatible

No problems with [redacted] with home learning. We have regular breaks. Hard for her to concentrate with her younger brother.

The home learning sent home has been great especially the videos where the teachers are explaining the work. This has meant that [redacted] can work more independently allowing me to work with [redacted] on his work that requires a bit more support.

I feel pressured by the amount of work assigned. Working full time and trying to home school is difficult. I'm worried if I don't do enough it looks bad on my child

[redacted] is enjoying her home learning and enjoys the mixture of different types of work sett. The reason I sat there is too much work is only because I work full time and struggle to support [redacted] as much as I would like. I would like to say the teachers are doing amazing and are supporting the children in so many ways. I'm proud that my child comes to this school and have such an amazing teaching staff around her.

Home learning is great.. I would just like some more work which will challenge my child. The work which he is doing he is able to do. However I understand not ever parent would be comfortable in teaching their child new skills etc. In school the learning would be more ability based and I think that's what I'm missing... I'm trying to incorporate my own ideas as well as school work.

Please explain this to the teacher when they call. They can upload additional tasks to your child's Class Dojo portfolio.

We are using class dojo as our main source of home learning. My child [REDACTED] and i are very happy with it. Lots of different video's and story's and also lots of links to access other sites. Easy to post pictures of [REDACTED] work and he gets to see what comments the teachers write. The school is doing a fantastic job in this difficult situation we are currently in. I hope the teachers get the praise they deserve. Thank you.

Appears to little consideration to parents who have to work and struggle balance that with home working. While I appreciate the children's efforts need to be encouraged sending videos about awarding stars to those that have posted lots of demonstrated achievements could be demoralising for those who are unable to post their accomplishments but are still working.

All children are submitting some form of work. For some this is the completion of set tasks, for others it is photos and videos of other practical things they are learning at home. Both of these are appreciated and recognised as important.

At the moment [REDACTED] needs a lot of support with the tasks set which I've been surprised about but think this is more to do with the change of environment and lack of confidence. Working at home is very different to being in a classroom surrounded by peers and staff. We are adjusting to the change and I'm happy to give him the support he needs. I'm sure that gradually he'll become more independent. We've explained the importance of having a structured day and he's respectful and understanding of this even though he says his friends don't do the work. Again we've talked through this and explained about being responsible for your own actions so he gives himself the best opportunities instead of being led by others when it may well be exaggerated anyway! We can appreciate the hard work that's gone into setting up home learning and are grateful for this. Having set work to do and a timetable to follow is much easier and motivating than just choosing work ourselves from BBC bitesize etc. It also gives me more confidence that the work we are doing is in keeping with the curriculum etc. Thanks again

[REDACTED] has been really struggling with the tasks set on school website and I am also finding it difficult to help her and I am struggling to try and work with both [REDACTED] as they both need support I have spoke to mr Parker who has really helped us this week and made it feel a little less stressful I am very great full for the phone calls home as it really does help

The work provided is explained well and I am able to adjust it to suit [redacted] ability if I feel he needs challenging further. We are happy there is no need for joining zoom calls etc as I feel at such a early age this wouldn't have been achievable. [redacted]
