Health & Safety Reminders.

It has been part of our school risk assessment that parents wear **face masks** whilst on the school grounds for some time now and this **HAS NOT CHANGED**. Over the past couple of weeks we have noticed that masks are not consistently being worn and staff are having to remind parents. We understand that sometimes people forget their masks, but on these occasions we ask that you visit the school office, where we will happily supply you with one.



We are proud that the number of cases in school and in our immediate community (including staff and parents) is minimal and that we have not suffered as much as other schools who have had to continually close teaching bubbles. We firmly believe that it is due to our robust risk assessments and cleanliness in and around school that has contributed to this success story. We are all working hard to protect your children and expect **ALL PARENTS** to fully support this by following our rules to wear a mask whilst on the school premises. Thank you to those of you who have respectfully provided evidence of your exemption. If you are exempt and have not shown your medical card to a staff member then please do so as soon as you can or email a copy to the school office.

We **WILL NOT** accept any verbal abuse from anyone not following the rules or complaining about staff asking where their masks are. We speak to you respectfully and expect the same in return. We will not hesitate to refuse any parent entry to the site if this is the case. All of our staff should feel safe and happy to come to work and care for your children (of which they do a wonderful job) without being treated inappropriately. I am sure that you would agree that this is the case in your own workplaces.

ONE WAY SYSTEM

Please can we also remind you about the one way system in place. If you have a KS1 and KS2 child you can enter through the KS1 entrance and move round to the KS2 area. If you do not have a KS1 child please do not use this entrance. If you have a Y3/4 child and a Year 5/6 child, please enter through the Y3/4 entrance and exit through the Y5/6 exit, therefore keeping to the one way system. One parent per family please. Thank you to parents who continue to follow our rules and for your continued support.
