Dear Parents and Carers,

As promised, we would like to update you regarding the arrangements for returning to school. As you may know, the restrictions regarding Covid-19 have been lifted and things are slowly returning to normal. There are some things which educational setting as still required to continue, for example regular handwashing and hygiene routines and appropriate ventilation, but these measures are ones the children are very used to now, and do not have any negative impact on their learning or school experiences.

You are no longer required to enter and exit through specific gates or to follow a one-way system. You are free to use whichever entrance and exit is most suitable to yourselves.
