Covid Arrangements and Developments

As you may all be aware, covid cases continue to be on the rise in Telford and Wrekin.

We would like to try to continue to offer the familiar experiences in school but also have to consider the safety of our children, staff and parents.

Parental consultations will continue to go ahead next week with some small changes which we have already mentioned. Please only arrive for your given time slot.

For the appointments in the afternoons during the school day, you will need to arrive at the main office and will be asked to sanitize your hands and then will be seen into the school hall where your child's class teacher will be waiting to meet with you at a suitable distance. Some of our teachers are choosing to wear a mask for this appointment.

For the appointments after school on the Wednesday, you will need to go to your child's classroom door that you normally drop off and collect from. You will be greeted by your child's class teacher at your allocated time slot and your consultation will take place at a suitable distance in the classroom. You will be seen out of the same door and asked to go round the building to the next class teachers door if you have another appointment for a sibling.

There will be no option to wait inside, walk through the school or look at books whilst you wait.

Please note that if you are waiting outside you may need to wear suitable warm clothing or have an umbrella if the weather is wet.

Christmas Performances will unfortunately not go ahead this year. We have sought advice from the Health Protection Hub who have provided us with a long list of requirements which would need to be in place if they did (including significantly limiting numbers, mask wearing, ventilation, one way systems and increased cleaning) and have made the decision that these would all be a lot of work for something that could potentially be cancelled at the last minute if we had cases in school.

Therefore, we have decided to celebrate in school with the children as we normally would, with the added opportunity for the children to make something special to bring home to their families for the holidays.

We hope that you understand our decisions and that they haven't been made lightly or without sufficient advice and guidance or consideration for how disappointed we know the children, staff and yourselves are when things have to be cancelled at the last minute.
