Year 1 and 2 Educational Visit to the Exotic Zoo, Telford

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our theme learning for Spring 1 is called 'All creatures great and small'. In this theme we look closely at the similarities and differences between animals; their looks, habitats and feeding habits.

For our exciting theme opener, we would like to take the children of Year 1 and Year 2 on a visit to the Exotic Zoo, whilst there they will get to see (and possibly handle) a range of different animals. We will also be taking part in a workshop set up by the staff of Exotic Zoo that will greatly support the children's learning for that half term. To consolidate our learning from Autumn 2, 'Exploring My Community' we will also take the opportunity to have a little walk around Southwater and the Town Park (weather permitting).

The date of the visit will be Wednesday 12th January 2022. Children will leave school after registration and will return for the end of the day. They will be asked to bring a packed lunch, or you can request a school sandwich through ParentPay. The children will be eating in a room provided by the Exotic Zoo.

The cost of the visit including transport will be £7.76 and we kindly ask that this is paid for via ParentPay before Friday 7th January 2022.

We hope that the weather will be dry, however we will still be in winter, and it will be cold so ask that your child wears their uniform with a warm, waterproof coat and sensible warm shoes.
