<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Mr Palin asked a variety of questions to the School Councillors, to gather information about what they thought about the school menu. ◆ The School Councillors were asked 3 questions about the School Dinners/ Menu. 1) <i>Who has a hot dinner?</i> 2) <i>What do you like/ dislike about the menu?</i> 3) <i>If you were to add anything to the menu, what would it be?</i> ◆ They suggested how improvements could be made to the menu, to make it tastier and explained how if the menu was updated, then they will be more likely to eat a hot dinner, rather than bringing in a pack lunch from home. ◆ The School Councillors will ask their class 3 questions about the School Menu and then discuss their findings, in a meeting, within two weeks time.
