Dear Parents/Carers,

For the autumn half term, as part of our History we are going to be learning about homes past and present. To spark the imaginations of the children, we are planning to visit The Black Country Museum and take a guided tour of the homes from different generations. The date for this is Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

We are planning to leave school at 9am and arrive back here for approximately 15:00, meaning the children can be collected at normal time. There will be updates posted to the class dojo/school twitter if there are any problems with delays etc.

We will require the children to come to school in their school uniform. In addition to this, they will need to wear sensible/comfortable shoes and dress appropriately for the weather e.g. coats if there is a chance of rain. Children will need a packed lunch, it is advised they bring a backpack as they will be carrying it around with them. If your child requires a school packed lunch, please choose this option on ParentPay.



The cost of the trip is £16.00. This will be the only trip they will attend during the Autumn term. The cost of this trip includes the entry fee, a guided tour, the chance to explore the many exciting parts of the museum, and the cost of the transport. This will need to be paid in full by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023. You can pay via ParentPay, give consent and order an optional packed lunch any time after Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July (This is to allow the administrative team time to change classes for next year).

I hope that we are giving you enough notice to pay the cost of the trip, but should you have any difficulties then do not hesitate to contact us. This will be a great opportunity for the children and allow them to get excited to explore how homes have changed throughout history. As always, whilst the school can subsidise a small amount, if enough interest is not received and the trip is not financially viable it will have to be cancelled.
