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Reading Key Stage One

Dear Parents/Carers,

In school we use the Reading scheme Read Write Inc (RWi), the scheme ensures that the books which your child reads at home directly relate to the sounds (phonics) which they learn in class.

The children will keep this book for a week and be expected to read it each day and develop their fluency (the confidence, speed and accuracy that they read with). All schools used to swap books much more regularly, but it has been proven that a child reading the same book a few times really does support their fluency. Hopefully reading the same book at home will support your child to read faster, grow in confidence and support the daily reading in class.

In order to develop your child's understanding, there are a couple of questions at the back of each book for you to discuss. Please can we

ask that you record the name of the book and the dates on which the book was read in their Reading Record. Every time your reads at home, they get earn a sticker for their bookmark. A complete bookmark rewards them a new book from our special book box to keep and bring home and their name is put on our school reading tree in the school hall (see photo).

In order to further boost a love of reading, children will now be reading their book from the moment they come into school, before registration, so they need their Reading Record and book each day.

If you have any questions or would like support in reading with your child at home, then do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher or me!
