Dear Parents & Carers,

The government and the LA have instructed schools to close from Monday 23rd March 2020 for most pupils.

We are waiting for the government to publish more information on what this means, but it would help us in the meantime if you could contact us by phoning the school office or emailing a2175@telford.gov.uk if you think you fall into one of these categories as a 'Key Worker' resulting in you needing your child to return to school from Monday 23rd March.

Medical professionals including doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics etc.

Other health workers - such as employment in a medical/health setting

Community safety - police force and fire brigade

Education - teachers, workers in a school or a pre-school setting

Supermarket workers

Delivery drivers

Anyone working in "critical infrastructure" - possibly like gas and electricity

We'll be in touch again as soon as we are sure who this does apply to.

All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday onwards.

Please note that this is a national closure - as you may have heard in the news - so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We'll re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is via the front page of the website, twitter and the school section of the class dojo app.

You can still contact the administration and senior leadership team through the contact form on the school website should you need to. Unfortunately, the personal message element of class dojo remains disabled so teachers will be unable to reply to these.

Your child should have come home with a learning pack. Where possible we would advise these to be used in moderation across the time the school remains closed. We continue to request that you encourage your child to read as much as possible and continue to record in their diaries so that rewards can still be claimed upon return to school. As we are unsure of the length of time school will be closed, then further resources and activities can be accessed via the new page on the school website.
